

# Tips for Attending a Medical Panel for Workers



## The following are a few tips to help you prepare for your Medical Panel:

- There is ample parking, including underground parking in the building (10405 Jasper Avenue). You can access this parking lot from 105 Street Northbound, just south of Jasper Avenue. There are several Edmonton Transit System routes available nearby. Additional information is available upon request.
- This is an accessible office. Reasonable accommodations will be considered upon request.
- The office is secure. There is a telephone at the entrance to request access.
- Please bring government issued photo identification to confirm your identity prior to the Medical Panel beginning.
- Recordings are not permitted during the Medical Panel, and you may be asked to turn off your mobile device or leave the room while it is in use.
- Wear comfortable clothing as you may be sitting for extended periods and a medical examination may be required. There is an examination room in the Medical Panels office.
- Water, coffee, and tea will be provided in the Medical Panel conference room. There are several options for food around the office should you require a meal before or after the Medical Panel.
- An interpreter and/or chaperone can be made available, if required. A minimum of three weeks' notice to the Registrar is required to make the arrangements.
- If desired, you may bring your Medical Information Package with you for disposal.
- Childcare is not provided.
